ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFF'S MOTION FOR PRELIMINARY APPROVAL OF CLASS ACTION SETTLEMENT

PROPOSED ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFF'S MOT. FOR PRELIM. APPROVAL



The above-titled matter came before this Court upon Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement. Based upon the memoranda, exhibits, and all the files and proceedings herein, the Court finds as follows:

- 1. The Court grants preliminary approval of the Settlement Agreement and Release attached as Exhibit 1 to the Declaration of Julian Hammond in Support of Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement ("Settlement Agreement"), based upon the terms set forth in the Settlement Agreement.
- 2. The settlement terms set forth in the Settlement Agreement appear to be fair, adequate and reasonable to the Class Members, and the Court preliminarily approves the terms of the Settlement Agreement.
- 3. The Court grants the parties' request for certification of the following Rule 23 settlement class for the sole and limited purpose of implementing the terms of the Settlement Agreement, subject to this Court's final approval:

All individuals identified by Employee ID on **Exhibit A** to the Settlement Agreement who worked remotely from home in Seattle for Egencia at any time between June 23, 2020 and October 31, 2022.

- 4. The Court preliminarily appoints Plaintiff's counsel, HammondLaw P.C. as Class Counsel, and Plaintiff as Class Representative.
- 5. This Court approves, as to form and content, the Notice of Proposed Class Action Settlement ("Class Notice"), in substantially the form attached to the Settlement Agreement as **Exhibit B** to the Settlement Agreement. The Court approves the procedure for Class Members to opt out of, or object to, the Settlement Agreement as set forth in the Settlement Agreement and the Class Notice.
- 6. A final fairness hearing on the question of whether the proposed Settlement Agreement, attorneys' fees and costs to Class Counsel, and the Class Representative Service Award should be finally approved as fair, reasonable and adequate as to the Class Members is scheduled for September 20, 2024 at 9:00 am. Class Counsel shall file their motion for final approval of the Settlement Agreement, and their motion for attorneys' fees and costs and service award to the Class Representative, no later than nine (9) judicial days prior to the final fairness hearing.
