23 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**


- 24 1. The Court grants preliminary approval and conditional certification of the Class for
25 settlement purposes only;
- 26 2. The Court grants preliminary approval of Plaintiff Megan Snodgrass as Class
27 Representative;
- 28 3. The Court grants preliminary approval of Otkupman Law Firm, A Law Corporation, as Class

- 4. The Court grants preliminary approval of Settlement as set forth in the Class Action and PAGA Settlement Agreement (the "Settlement Agreement");
- 5. The Court finds that the Class Notice meets the requirements of California Code of Civil Procedure section 382 and due process, and the notice as directed constitutes the best notice practicable under the circumstances;
- 6. The Court sets a Final Approval Hearing on January 17, 2025 at 1:30 p.m. in Department C-63 to consider whether the proposed Settlement Agreement, the allocation of payments to Class Members, attorneys' fees and costs to Class Counsel, payment of PAGA penalties to the Labor Workforce & Development Agency, and Plaintiff's Enhancement Award should be finally approved as fair, reasonable, and adequate as to the members of the Class. This hearing may be continued at the Court's discretion. All supporting papers must be filed no later than sixteen (16) court days prior to the hearing.
- 7. Any member of the class who has not timely elected to be excluded or who objects to the proposed settlement may appear at the hearing. Any Class Member who does not make a valid objection will be deemed to have waived any such objection.
- 8. All discovery and other pre-trial proceedings are stayed, except such actions as may be necessary to implement the settlement.
