ORDER

By order dated September 26, 2024 (ROA 629), the court granted plaintiff David Lawson's motion for class certification. Having reviewed plaintiff's Statement Regarding Class Notice filed October 7, 2024 (ROA 637) and its attachments, no objections thereto having been filed, and in accordance with California Rule of Court 3.766(c), the court hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. Notice to the class is necessary;
2. Class Members shall have the opportunity to exclude themselves from the action;
3. Notice shall be given in substantially the same manner as proposed in Plaintiff's Statement Regarding Class Notice (ROA 637);
4. The content of the notice, as modified in accordance with the court's concurrently-issued order, shall be substantially similar to the proposed notice attached as Exhibit 1 to Plaintiff's Statement Regarding Class Notice (ROA 637);
5. The court appoints APEX as the Administrator (*see* ROA 637, Ex. 2); and
6. The parties shall share the cost of administration of the class notice 50-50.
