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3 Plaintiff David Lawson's ("Plaintiff") Motion to Modify the Court's October 16, 2024 Order
4 Approving Class Notice came before this Court on August 7, 2025 at 2:00 p.m. before the Honorable
5 Melissa R. McCormick in Department CX-105 of the Superior Court of California, in and for the
6 County of Orange. The Court, having considered Plaintiff's Motion and all papers filed in support, no
7 oppositions to the motion having been filed, and good cause appearing, **HEREBY ORDERS THE**
8 **FOLLOWING:**

9 1. The Court's October 16, 2024 Order Approving Class Notice (ROA 650) is modified as
10 follows:

11 a. Notice to the Class Members shall be given in substantially the same manner as
12 proposed in Plaintiff's Statement Regarding Class Notice (ROA 637), with the
13 exception that, as an alternative to using the Class Members' Data to compile the
14 Class List, Class Counsel may compile the Class List from (1) the class list
15 produced by Defendant Executive Maintenance, Inc. on January 19, 2022; (2) the
16 "Employee Job Agreement" forms produced by Defendant Executive
17 Maintenance, Inc.; (3) the timesheets produced by Defendant Executive
18 Maintenance, Inc.; (4) the wage statements produced by Defendant Executive
19 Maintenance, Inc.; and (5) declarations obtained from Class Members.

20 b. Class Counsel is not required to send a proposed Class List compiled from this
21 information to Defendants' counsel or to secure Defendants' counsel's approval
22 before sending the Class List to the Administrator, but shall serve Defendants'
23 counsel with a copy of the Class List at the same time Class Counsel sends the
24 Class List to the Administrator.

25 2. All other aspects of the October 16, 2024 Order Approving Class Notice remain in full
26 force and effect.

27 3. Therefore, the Court orders the Parties to comply with the Amended Class Notice Schedule, as
28 follows:

<u>Deadline for Class Counsel to Provide the Class List and Class Data to the Administrator</u>	August 18, 2025
<u>Deadline for the Administrator to Update Class Member Addresses and Contact Information</u>	August 25, 2025 or within 7 calendar days of receiving the Class List and Class Data, whichever is sooner
<u>Deadline for the Administrator to Complete the Mailing of the Class Notice</u>	September 1, 2025 or within 14 calendar days of receiving the Class List and Class Data, whichever is sooner
<u>Deadline for the Re-Mailing of Undeliverable Notices</u>	Within three (3) business days of receipt
<u>Deadline for Class Members to submit Request for Exclusion ("Response Deadline")</u>	October 16, 2025 or 45 calendar days from the mailing of the Class Notice, whichever is sooner
<u>Deadline for the Administrator to Send Class Counsel the Final Class List</u>	October 23, 2025 or within 7 calendar days of the Response Deadline, whichever is sooner
