6 the following paragraphs in their previously executed Joint Stipulation of Class Action and PAGA  
7 Settlement (“Settlement Agreement”) as follows:

8 **AMENDMENT NO. 1**

9 ***Amendment to Settlement Agreement Paragraph 7***

10 7. “Class Period” means the period commencing on October 21, 2020, through the  
11 date of Preliminary Approval, or the date as provided in Paragraph 39(b).

12 **AMENDMENT NO. 2**

13 ***Amendment to Settlement Agreement Paragraph 20***

14 20. “PAGA Period” means the period from December 2, 2023, through the date of  
15 Preliminary Approval, or the date as provided in Paragraph 39(b).

16 **AMENDMENT NO. 3**

17 ***Amendment to Settlement Agreement Paragraph 29***

18 29. “Released PAGA Claims” means all claims under the California Labor Code  
19 Private Attorneys General Act of 2004 for civil penalties that could have been premised on the  
20 facts alleged in Plaintiff Paul Anthony Enriquez’s December 2, 2024, PAGA Letter to the LWDA  
21 or any facts alleged in the Actions, including but not limited to penalties that could have been  
22 awarded based on alleged violations of Labor Code sections 201, 202, 203, 204, 210, 226, 226.3,  
23 226.7, 510, 512, 515, 558, 558.1, 1174, 1174.5, 1182.12, 1185, 1194, 1194.2, 1197, 1197.1, 1198,  
24 1199, 2698, 2699, *et seq.*, and 2802; provisions of the Industrial Welfare Commission Wage  
25 Orders; and California Business & Professions Code § 17200, *et seq.*, including all related claims  
26 for any attorneys’ fees, interest, penalties and costs.
