On December 26, 2025, this court entered an order granting final approval of the settlement of this class and PAGA action and awarding attorney's fees, costs, and service awards. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED THAT:


1. Judgment is hereby entered in accordance with the terms of this court's final approval order.
2. The Settlement Classes are defined as follows:
 - The "Class" is defined as: all current and former non-exempt employees who were

1 employed by Defendant within the State of California at any time from September 11,
2 2019, through November 17, 2024. (Settlement Agreement, ¶¶ 1.5, 1.9.)

- 3 • “PAGA Aggrieved Employees” are defined as: all individuals currently or formerly
4 employed by Defendant as non-exempt, hourly-paid employees in California who were
5 employed by Defendant in California from July 8, 2022, through the date of
6 preliminary approval, which was June 26, 2025. (Settlement Agreement ¶¶ 1.4, 1.35,
7 Order Granting Preliminary Approval)

- 8 3. No class members objected, opted out or requested exclusion.
- 9 4. Pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure section 664.6, and Rule 3.769(h) of the California Rules of
10 Court and without impacting the finality of this judgment – the court retains jurisdiction over
11 plaintiffs, all members of the Settlement Classes, and defendants for the purpose of supervising
12 the implementation, enforcement, construction, administration, and interpretation of the
13 Settlement Agreement, Final Approval Order, and judgment thereon.
