1 Plaintiffs Tracey Hall, Saya Kadota, Maho Kuzuoka, and Juno Medina (“Plaintiffs”) and
2 Defendants Shigeta America, Inc. d/b/a Shin-Sen-Gumi and Mitsuyasu Shigeta (“Defendants”)
3 (with Plaintiffs, the “Parties”), by and through their respective counsel of record, hereby stipulate as
4 follows:

5 WHEREAS, on May 30, 2025, the Court granted Preliminary Approval of the Class and
6 PAGA Settlement reached by the Parties in the above-captioned matter;

7 WHEREAS, on May 30, 2025, the Court set a hearing date for the Motion for Final
8 Approval for October 22, 2025 at 9 a.m. and ordered that the Parties file a Motion for Final
9 Approval by September 30, 2025;

10 WHEREAS, upon a stipulation filed by the Parties regarding issues regarding the class list
11 and data that Defendants’ counsel and the settlement administrator, Apex Class Action (“Apex”),
12 were working through to refine and finalize, the Court ordered that the hearing on the Motion for
13 Final Approval be continued to March 11, 2026 with the Motion papers to be filed no later than 16
14 court days before the new hearing date (February 17, 2026);

15 WHEREAS, on February 6, 2026, Apex reached out to the Parties stating that while
16 preparing their declaration, they noticed that their records reflected zero returned notices and given
17 the class size, this seemed unusual, so they conducted a more detailed investigation. Their review
18 determined that, due to a technical glitch in their software, approximately 70 notices that were
19 returned to their office were not flagged as “Returned” in their system and therefore, were not skip
20 traced and remained;

21 WHEREAS, Apex has represented that they can conduct a skip trace and re-mail any
22 notices to these approximately 70 class members with new contact information on February 9,
23 2026, giving them 60 days to respond (e.g. opt out, object, lodge a dispute);

24 WHEREAS, in order to give all class members an opportunity to receive notice and
25 respond, the Parties believe the Motion for Final Approval motion hearing date needs to be pushed
26 out accordingly;

27 Now, THEREFORE, it is hereby STIPULATED AND AGREED by the Parties, through
28 their respective counsel as follows: The hearing on the Motion for Final Approval is continued from

1 March 11, 2026 to May 11, 2026 or a date shortly thereafter, with the Motion for Final Approval to
2 be filed no later than 16 court days before the new hearing date.


