The Court finds as follows:

The Court adopts its tentative.

The Court grants Plaintiffs' Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action and PAGA Settlement in accordance with California Rules of Court rule 3.769, Code of Civil Procedure section 382, and Labor Code section 2699(1)(2). The Court grants conditional certification to the proposed class for settlement purposes only. The Court appoints Plaintiffs Priscilla Jerrera and Brittany Davidson as Class Representative, Apex Class Action, LLC as claims administrator, and Protection Law Group, LLP and Lawyers for Justice P.C. as Class Counsel for settlement

purposes only. Additionally, the Court approves, as to form and content, Plaintiff's proposed direct-mail notice. The Court directs the mailing of this document, together with a postage-paid return envelope, to the proposed class, and finds that the proposed implementation schedule satisfies the requirements of due process.

The Court sets a final approval hearing on 07/27/2026 at 8:30 a.m. in Division J.
