1 The Motion of Plaintiff Roseanna Magdaleno (“Plaintiff”) for Preliminary Approval of  
2 Class Action and PAGA Settlement came on regularly for hearing before this Court. This Court,  
3 having considered the proposed Class Action and PAGA Settlement Agreement (the “Agreement”  
4 or “Settlement”) attached to the Declaration of William C. Sung filed concurrently herein; having  
5 considered Plaintiff’s Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action and PAGA Settlement,  
6 Memorandum of Points and Authorities in support thereof, and supporting declarations filed  
7 therewith; and good cause appearing, HEREBY ORDERS THE FOLLOWING:

8 1. The Court GRANTS preliminary approval of the class action settlement as set forth  
9 in the Settlement and finds its terms to be within the range of reasonableness of a settlement that  
10 ultimately could be granted approval by the Court at a Final Approval Hearing. For purposes of the  
11 Settlement, the Court finds that the proposed Class is ascertainable and that there is a sufficiently  
12 well-defined community of interest among the members of the Class in questions of law and fact.  
13 Therefore, for settlement purposes only, the Court grants conditional certification of the following  
14 Class:

15 All current and former non-exempt or hourly paid employees who worked for  
16 Defendant Milky Way International Trading Corporation in California at any time  
during the Class Period of December 11, 2020 through March 10, 2026.

17 2. For purposes of the Settlement, the Court designates named Plaintiff Roseanna  
18 Magdaleno as Class Representative and William C. Sung, Tiffany L. Luu, Joseph C. Ramli of  
19 Justice for Workers, P.C. as Class Counsel.

20 3. The Court designates Apex Class Action LLC as the third-party Administrator for  
21 mailing notices.

22 4. The Court approves, as to form and content, the Class Notice attached as Exhibit A  
23 to the Settlement.

24 5. The Court finds that the form of notice to the Class regarding the pendency of the  
25 action and of the Settlement, and the methods of giving notice to Class Members, constitute the best  
26 notice practicable under the circumstances, and constitute valid, due, and sufficient notice to all of  
27 the Class Members. The form and method of giving notice complies fully with the requirements of  
28 California Code of Civil Procedure section 382, California Civil Code section 1781, California

1 Rules of Court 3.766 and 3.769, the California and United States Constitutions, and other applicable  
2 law.

3 6. The Court further approves the procedures for the Class Members to opt out of or  
4 object to the Settlement, as set forth in the Class Notice.

5 7. The procedures and requirements for filing objections in connection with the Final  
6 Approval Hearing are intended to ensure the efficient administration of justice and the orderly  
7 presentation of any Class Member's objection to the Settlement in accordance with the due process  
8 rights of all members of the Class.

9 8. The Court directs the Administrator to mail the Class Notice to Class Members in  
10 accordance with the terms of the Settlement.

11 9. The Class Notice shall provide at least forty-five (45) calendar days' notice for Class  
12 Members to opt out of, or object to, the Settlement.

13 10. The Final Approval Hearing on the question of whether the Settlement should be  
14 finally approved as fair, reasonable, and adequate is scheduled in Department 17 of this Court,  
15 located at Spring Street Courthouse, located at 312 North Spring Street, Los Angeles, CA 90012 on  
16 November 23, 2026 at 9:00 a.m./p.m.

17 11. At the Final Approval Hearing, the Court will consider: (a) whether the Settlement  
18 should be finally approved as fair, reasonable, and adequate for the Class; (b) whether a judgment  
19 granting final approval of the Settlement should be entered; and (c) whether Plaintiff's application  
20 for reasonable attorneys' fees, reimbursement of litigation expenses, service award to Plaintiff,  
21 settlement administration costs, and payment to the Labor & Workforce Development Agency  
22 ("LWDA") for penalties under the Labor Code Private Attorneys General Act should be granted.

23 12. Counsel for the parties shall file memoranda, declarations, or other statements and  
24 materials in support of their request for final approval of the Settlement, attorneys' fees, litigation  
25 expenses, Plaintiff's service payment, payment to the LWDA, and settlement administration costs,  
26 no later than 16 court days prior to the Final Approval Hearing.

Defendant to provide the Administrator with the Class Data	Within 15 calendar days after entry of this Order
Administrator to mail the Class Notice	Within 14 calendar days after receiving the Class Data from Defendant
Response Deadline for Class Members	Within 45 calendar days after the Administrator mails the Class Notice (extended by 14 calendar days for any re-mailed initial Class Notices)
Last Day to File a Motion for Final Approval of Class Action and PAGA Settlement	At least 16 court days before the Final Approval Hearing:
Final Approval Hearing	November 23, 2026 at 9:00 a.m./p.m.

11           14.     Pending the Final Approval Hearing, all proceedings in this Action, other than  
12 proceedings necessary to carry out or enforce the terms and conditions of the Settlement and this  
13 Order, are stayed.

14           15.     Counsel for the parties are hereby authorized to utilize all reasonable procedures in  
15 connection with the administration of the Settlement which are not materially inconsistent with  
16 either this Order or the terms of the Settlement.

17           **IT IS SO ORDERED.**
